Made out of silicone, it detects colour frequencies. With just a squeeze, it sucks in a few hundred frequencies of colour and beams it through the light bulb.

MYX LAMP

Made from combining the vegetative part of fungi (waste collected from a commercial mushroom farm), with plant filaments (leftover from the textile industry), the MYX lamp is both a design product and a sustainable industrial solution. The lamp is bio-degradable in 60 days and consists only of mushroom mycelium and hemp fibre.



P.E.A.D NOT DEAD

This is an experimental process for manufacturing vases from low- or high-density polyethylene (LDPE or HDPE) used containers. LDPE or HDPE, the thermoplastic polymer that is made up of repeating units of ethylene, creates a structure that is linear and un-branched. Each container results in a colourful yet slightly raw-looking vase with an eclectic touch.





RANDONNEUR CHAIR

It is made using traditional bicycle frame-building techniques, and employs the geometries of a Randonneur bike.



WOODNWONDER
